The following table reflects spending on faculty professional development, assessment, and technology. It is very important to note that these figures reflect only expenditures from the Dean's Discretionary account (from indirect grant costs), the Feinstein Endowment funds, and the RITER grant. These figures do not reflect significant expenditures the College makes for all three purposes, as well as salaries of key personnel involved in development and maintenance of the assessment system: the Assessment Director and Assistant Director, the Associate Dean for teacher Education, the Data Coordinator, two graduate assistants, the Assistant Dean for Partnerships and Placements, etc.
