Praxis II Content Social Studies Exam

All applicants for the M.A.T. program must include Praxis II test scores as part of their application package. Candidates are required to pass the exam with a minimum score of 157 to be accepted into the program, with an ideal score of 162. The exam aligns directly with NCSS Themes/Standards 1.1., 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 1.6, 1.7, 1.10, and 2.1. These scores are also used to determine whether students need to take additional content courses to meet NCSS standards.

The four students in the three cohorts all reaches our minimum required score of 157, and each also achieved our ideal score of 161. This indicates that the M.A.T. program, through a combination of admissions evaluation, regular program assessment, and required graduate courses in History, is adequately serving the needs of our students.
